Plans will be monitored and changed as we see fit, as we continue to work through this process. FAWN-DOE-ROSA has put into place the **P.A.W.S Plan**:

- 🐾 **Protect:** Everyone needs to protect themselves the best they can. We need to be respectful to individual needs. Please cover your mouth and nose especially when you cough and sneeze. If you are sick or have been around someone who is please stay home and take care of you. Your health is important to many. Masks are up to the individual.
- 🐾 **Awareness:** COVID-19 is new to many of us and people are doing the best with the information that is provided. As we know, things can and will change – week by week even day by day. FAWN-DOE-ROSA will do its best with the information that is provided. We have signage and staff will continue to be around the park to assist our guests and monitor our animal family.

Fun fact: Most of our fencing is more than 7 feet from post to post this provides a good visual.
